We understand from FEFANA that DG SANTE is looking after authenticity of certificates where ingredients are stated as chemically synthetized while the origin is different (vegetable or animal). By looking at custom codes it is not possible to establish if a product is produced by fermentation, chemical synthesis or other. This is why DG SANTE decided to launch this call for data as to receive a feedback from EU operators and increase their knowledge; there is no legal initiative in mind, the Unit is only in charge to study the matter (not in charge of legal action).
